TOTUS TUUS REGISTRATION TODAY: Set aside the week of July 24th for another fun-filled, faith-packed stretch of activity this summer with Totus Tuus. The high school and junior high school program will be Sunday through Thursday 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM. Grade school will gather Monday through Friday from 9:30 AM to 2:30 PM. If it is hot, the spacious Parish Hall will keep us cool. If not, we will use both the hall and the great outdoors for all the activities. Registration will be soon – so save the week of July 24th. CATHOLIC SERVICE APPEAL: Our annual diocesan fund drive (CSA) is still underway. An offering envelope should have been mailed directly to you from the Diocese that you may send your donation directly to the Diocese. Any checks are to be made out to the Diocese of Gary and NOT to the parish. This will greatly simplify the collection process and free parish personnel from the complicated task of managing the drive. If you have not received an envelope from the Diocese by mail, they will be available to you at Mass. As in the past, any donations that exceed our assigned goal, this year of \$9,408.00 for St. John Kanty and \$4,677.00 for St. Anthony, will be returned to the parish. In addition, the Bishop has decided to return 10% of the assigned goal amount to the parish as well, if the goal is reached. Please be aware that our goals have NOT yet been reached. If you have not contributed to the CSA, please consider donating. If our assigned goals are not met, the balance will have to be made up from our parish savings. The Diocese of Gary depends upon the yearly drive to meet the many expenses it has to fund its programs and offices that serve the people of our Diocese.

LIVE-STREAMED MASSES: The 4:00 PM Mass on Saturday and 9:30 AM Mass on Sunday from St. John Kanty is still being lived streamed. We will continue to live stream the weekend Mass from St. John Kanty for those who are confined to home, are sick, or have another grave reason for not being able to fulfill their obligation to attend Mass.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION: Please be aware that both St. John Kanty and St. Anthony have set aside special times for private Eucharistic Adoration of Our Lord. At St. John Kanty the Holy Eucharist is exposed on the altar each Sunday, following the 9:30 AM Mass until 12:00 Noon. At St. Anthony adoration follows the 8:00 AM Mass until 9:30 AM each Friday. Use these opportunities if you can to deepen your prayer life and your relationship with Our Lord by quietly spending this time with Eucharistic Christ. Incredible graces flow into the souls of those who regularly come into the penetrating presence of the Risen Christ.
