CGS AND CCD CLASSES BEGIN TODAY, SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 12TH: Our 2021-2022 religious education school year for St. John Kanty and St. Anthony of Padua begins, today, Sunday, September 12th. Classes for both our programs – CGS (Catechesis of the Good Shepherd) and CCD – will meet each Sunday from 10:30 AM until 12:00 Noon. CGS classes (a Montessori based program) will include children ages 3 thru 12. Level 1 (ages 3 thru 5) will meet in the Atrium in the basement below St. John Kanty church. Level 2 and Level 3 (ages 6 thru 12) will meet in the lower level of St. John Kanty Parish Hall. Seventh and eighth grade CCD classes will also meet in the lower level of St. John Kanty Parish Hall. The 9th thru 12th grade high school classes will meet in the upper level of St. John Kanty Parish Hall.

CGS/CCD SAFETY REMINDER: Drivers, please exercise caution when leaving the parking lots if you are driving through and/or dropping off your children. The children forget sometimes and could dart out as they run to CGS/CCD classes on Sundays.

STUDENTS: Please be careful as you head over to the hall for CGS/CCD classes on Sundays.

Drivers may not see you as you cross the parking lot to go to CGS/CCD classes.

RELIGIOUS ED PROGRAM FOR HIGH SCHOOL: Please be aware that St. John Kanty and St. Anthony of Padua will again be offering a program this year for high school students, that will augment their understanding of the Catholic Faith. It will take place during the same time frame as our regular CGS/CCD program – Sundays from 10:30 AM to 12:00 Noon at the St. John Kanty Parish Hall. Dr. James Capehart, who teaches at the Sacred Heart Apostolic School, will be giving the classes. Dr. Capehart will be utilizing texts from the Didache Series, an excellent publication used in many Catholic high schools.

At St. John Kanty the Holy Eucharist is exposed on the altar each Sunday, following the 9:30 AM Mass until 12:00 Noon. At St. Anthony adoration follows the 8:00 AM Mass until 9:30 AM each Friday. Use these opportunities if you can to deepen your prayer life and your relationship with Our Lord by quietly spending this time with Eucharistic Christ.
