ST. ANTHONY FOOD COLLECTION

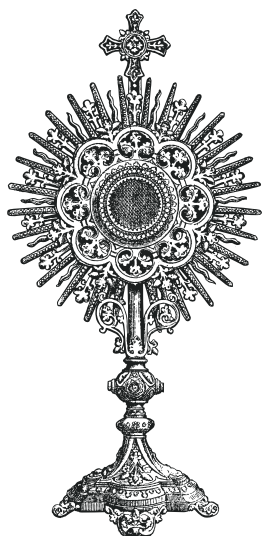
