

MASS DATES AVAILABLE

The most powerful gift you can give is to have a Mass offered for someone. If you would like to have Mass said for relatives or friends who have passed away or for personal intentions a large number of dates are available both now and in the foreseeable future. Drop your intention(s) in an envelope marked MASS, with the requested date(s) in the collection basket. In most cases the date that you requested is usually available, if not, the next available date will be scheduled. The usual stipend for a Mass in the Diocese of Gary is \$10.

LENTEN MASS & STATIONS OF THE CROSS

St. Anthony and St. John Kanty Churches will be having Mass and Stations of the Cross on Fridays of Lent. Mass and Stations at St Anthony will be at 8am and at St. John Kanty at 6pm.

LIVING STATIONS OF THE CROSS - 2023

All middle school (12 years old and up) and high school students are invited to participate in Living Stations at St. John Kanty, Rolling Prairie. Students will re-enact the fourteen Stations of the Cross in the church on Good Friday evening. Practices will be held in the church each Sunday beginning February 26th through April 2nd. THE DISCIPLINE OF LENT

FASTING:

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age through to those who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday.

THE CUSTOMARY FAST:

This fast allows for only one full meal to be taken during the day. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs. Eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

THE FAST OF THE EARLY CHURCH:

This fast begins upon rising, NO meals are taken until the customary workday (5pm) is ended. A glass of juice may be taken in the morning and simple liquids such as water, coffee and tea during the day. The fast ends with a brief prayer followed by an adequate meal. For many this may work as a more natural way to fast.



ABSTINENCE:

Abstinence is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and above.

TRADITIONAL ABSTINENCE:

This is the practice of refraining from meat and meat products.

ABSTINENCE AS PENANCE:

Entering fully into the spirit of the Lenten Fast and Paschal Fast, we are also encouraged to abstain from other foods, practices or activities.

FOOD PANTRY NEWS

ST. ANTHONY FOOD COLLECTION

St. Anthony Parish collects food for the needy and takes it to the St. Vincent de Paul Society in La Porte for distribution. Bring your donations <u>anytime</u> you come to Mass. Any items left in the back of church will be removed to the parish hall following Mass. If possible, however, it would be helpful if they could be brought to the parish hall. Just place them on one of the tables near the entrance to the kitchen. The need to restock St. Vincent de Paul's pantry is great. Whatever you can spare toward the ministry of feeding the hungry is much appreciated.
