EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

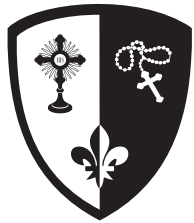

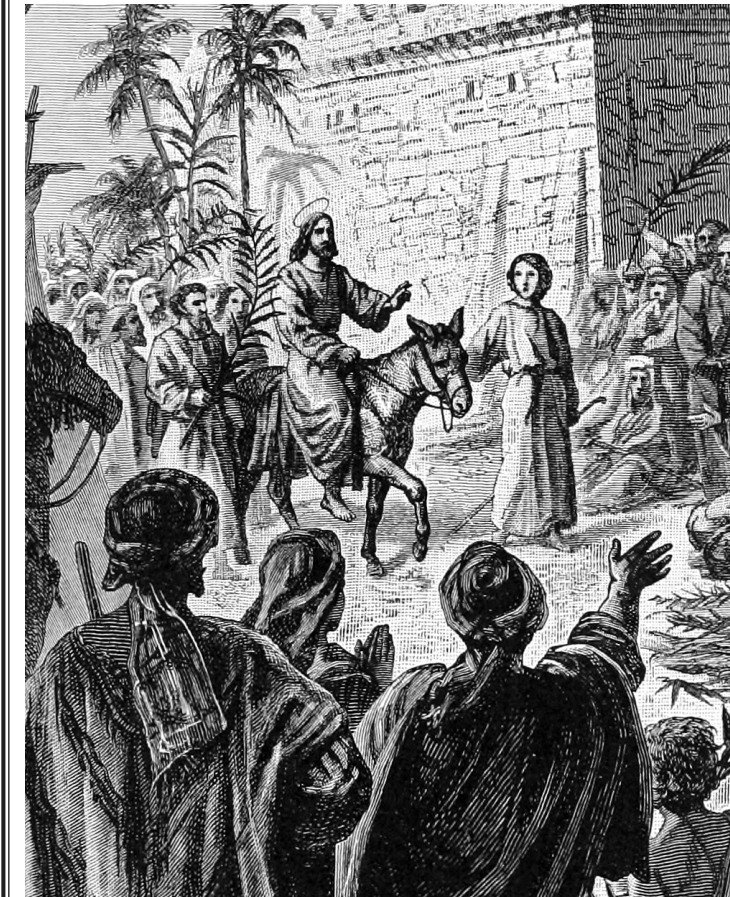
