

WE WELCOME OUR EUCHARISTIC PILGRIM LORD

The Gary Diocese has been preparing for the National Eucharistic Congress for about two years now. As part of the preparation for this momentous event, four different groups of pilgrims have been processing with the Holy Eucharist from four different corners of the United States in order to gather for the Eucharistic Congress at Indianapolis. One group is from California, another from Florida. One group is from the Eastern Seaboard and finally one group is from Minnesota. These groups of pilgrims have been walking from different areas on the country and will converge at Indianapolis for the Congress in a few weeks. On Friday, July 5th, one of those groups will be passing through the vicinity of Rolling Prairie. St. John Kanty will receive our Eucharistic pilgrim Lord on that day at noon when midday prayer from the Divine Office will be said and Benediction will be celebrated. This will be followed by a reception in the St. John Kanty Parish Hall. Most parishioners from both St. John Kanty and St. Anthony will be off work for the Independence Day long weekend, so we would like to see as many families as possible to be present at this special event.
