

NEW RAMP AT ST. JOHN KANTY

The major concrete work on the new ramp on the north side of St. John Kanty church building is completed. Temporary wooden rails have been installed. New stainless steel rails are being designed and fabricated and will be installed at a later date. The ramp in the meantime is totally usable. Because concrete undergoes a lengthy curing process, no ice melt salt may be used on it until the next winter season. For the current winter season, only sand may be used as a deterrent against snow and ice build up.
