O Lord of the harvest, send laborers into your vineyard. Pour your blessings on Collin Van Waardenburg. Keep him faithful to your Holy Will.





MASS DATES AVAILABLE

The most powerful gift you can give is to have a Mass offered for someone. If you would like to have Mass said for relatives or friends who have passed away or for personal intentions a large number of dates are available both now and in the foreseeable future. Drop your intention(s) in an envelope marked MASS, with the requested date(s) in the collection basket. In most cases the date that you requested is usually available, if not, the next available date will be scheduled. The usual stipend for a Mass in the Diocese of Gary is \$10.

LENTEN MASS & STATIONS OF THE CROSS

St. Anthony and St. John Kanty Churches will have Mass and Stations of the Cross on Fridays during Lent. Mass and Stations at St Anthony will be at 8am and at St. John Kanty at 6pm.

CATHOLIC SERVICE APPEAL

Our annual diocesan fund drive has begun. Parishioners should have already received an offering envelope mailed to them from the Diocese of Gary. Please return your donation directly to the Diocese and not to the parish. If you have not received an envelope from the Diocese, one will be available at the church entrances. In that case, place it in the Sunday collection and the parish will send it to the diocese processing center. This year's assigned goal for St. John Kanty is \$9,724 and the assigned goal for St. Anthony is \$6,581.

EASTER BASKET ITEMS NEEDED

St. Anthony Parish will once again be filling children's Easter baskets to be distributed by the St. Vincent de Paul Society food pantry in LaPorte. Treats to fill them are needed. Wrapped candy, including jellybeans, candy eggs, as well as small packs of chips, nuts or raisins, whatever you think will work, is welcomed. Please bring them to the St. Anthony Parish Hall next weekend (March 28 & 29) and they will be sorted and made into baskets for the children of families experiencing financially difficult times.

EXPERIENCE "THE RESCUE PROJECT"

Join us for an 8-week journey to discover the 4-part story of the Gospel: Created, Captured, Rescued, and Response. This is essentially a presentation of the retreat the priests of our Gary Diocese attended together last May. They said that it was one of the most powerful presentations that they had ever experienced and recommended that a version of it be made available to the people of our Diocese. Whether you are a life-long Catholic or new to the Faith, this journey offers a powerful message of hope through video and community discussion. It is being held from 10:30 to 11:30am (during religious education classes) in the St. John Kanty Parish Hall Lounge, just off the kitchen. **Also, for those unable to attend the Sunday sessions, each one will be repeated the following Monday evening at the Parish Hall from 6 to 7 pm Central Time.** It is open to all parishioners and parents. Those attending are welcome to remain for further discussion, fellowship and refreshments. This event is free and will run for 8 Sundays in conjunction with CGS/CCD religious education schedule breaking for 2 weeks at Easter. Come and see what the Lord has in store for you!
