Mary, Our Mother, protect John LaCorte and all of our priests and seminarians. Thank you for hearing our prayers. Amen.

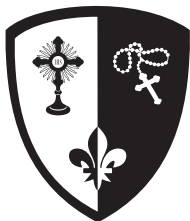
EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION
